**ORDER****Sub : Release of Fund against Requisition for PMKSY - OI Component**

As per the requisition sent by the Deputy Director of Agriculture (Administration), Malda, Memo No. of which is given in the column, the sanction and release of fund to Malda for implementing Other Interventions/SWMA works under PMKSY-PDMC for the FY:2019-20 is as follows :

The fund is allotted subject to the following terms and conditions :

- The sanctioned amount should be utilised as per Comprehensive Operational Guidelines for Bangla Krishi Sech Yojana in association with PMKSY- Per Drop More Crop – December 2018 (Memo No. 1013-18(28)/265/WBSWDA/PMKSY/EST/2016 dated 19/12/2018) for conducting Other Interventions/SWMA works. The detail of beneficiaries for Other Intervention should be uploaded in the portal ([www.pmksy.org](http://www.pmksy.org)) with linking with registered farmers under Micro Irrigation.
- Expenditure shall be made for the purpose it is allotted / sanctioned.
- No diversion of fund shall be allowed under any circumstances without prior approval of the Government.
- The Implementing Agencies will ensure that there is no duplication or overlapping of activities / areas covered under PMKSY vis-a-vis existing schemes of Central Government.
- The Implementing Agency /Authority shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure incurred and submit the statement of Audited Accounts and Utilization Certificates to this Department as soon as possible after the closure of the financial year.

- vi. The Accounts of the Implementing Agency shall be opened to Internal Audit of the Principal Accounts Officer, Department of Agriculture & Cooperation as well as Statutory Audit by the Comptroller & Auditor General of India at his discretion and he shall have the right to demand the production of books, accounts, connected vouchers and other documents and papers in this regard.
- vii. The Implementing Agency shall furnish Physical and Financial Progress Reports to this office on monthly basis in the prescribed format.
- viii. The Implementing Agency /Authority shall maintain Subsidiary Accounts and Ledger Book for the sanctioned amount and get the account audited relating to released amount from a Chartered Accountant to be appointed by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of the Government of India and Internal Audit.
- ix. The Audited Records of the assets (permanent or semi-permanent), acquired wholly or substantially, out of the grant to the Implementing Agency should be maintained as prescribed in the Form GFR 12C under General Financial Rules-2005. The consolidated statement of Utilization Certificate along with Statement of Accounts shall be furnished to the Government of India annually latest by the end of June, following the financial year to which it relates.
- x. The Implementing Agency should identify beneficiaries including SC /ST to achieve prescribed targets.
- xi. 30% of the total beneficiaries should be women.
- xii. Monthly Progress Reports and Cumulative Monthly Physical & Financial Progress Reports indicating unit cost norms, targets and corresponding achievements under various components are to be submitted to the WBSWDA by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the succeeding month as per the format circulated with the order dated 9/1/2019.
- xiii. The photographs with geo-spatial locations for each OI/SWMA installations should be geo-tagged and uploaded into the Bhuvan Portal using Bhuvan PDMC App.
- xiv. Scheme Management Cost is to be used for strengthening co-ordination, scientific planning and technical support for effective implementation of Micro Irrigation. At the field level the fund can be used for engagement of Contractual Staff for data entry into the MIS / monitoring / outsourcing of specific activities / recurring expenses of various kind. However, no permanent employment can be created nor can any vehicle be purchased.
- xv. Receipt of fund may be acknowledged.

The expenditure is to be booked under the head "SWMA on individual basis and SWMA on community basis" as the case may be.
